# **Utsunomiya City**

Promoting Utsunomiya as a cyclist-friendly community







- The city has held Japan Cup Cycle Road Race, the top-rated bicycle road race in Asia, every year since 1992. In addition, a professional cycle road racing team based in the city was established in 2009. These developments have raised citizens' interest in bicycles and cycling.
- Since 2003, city office has promoted wider and better use of bicycles amid changes in the social environment such as worsening congestion of automotive traffic, rising awareness of ecofriendly transportation, and aging society.



## Intervention

#### To increase safety of bicycles,

- Constructed bicycle only roads.
- Held traffic safety lessons in elementary schools collaborating with the cycle road racing team.

### To increase convenience of bicycles,

- Created bicycle parking lots near railway stations and bus stops.
- Established rest spots that allow cyclists to make simple repairs to their bikes in public facilities and convenience stores.

#### To promote tourism, health and environmental conservation,

- Created the facility where cyclists can use the bathroom and rest areas for free in the city centre.
- Expanded bicycle rental services.
- Examined physical data of those who started commuting by bicycle rather than car

## **Impact**

- In 2013, the number of accidents involving bicycles fell 40% from 2008.
- Many citizens and tourists from other areas are using facilities that the city set up.
